Local Transport and Termination Services (LTTS)

Enclosed is one copy of Climax's Tariff M.P.S.C. No. 23R revisions for filing with the Commission pursuant to Public Act 179 of 1991, as amended, MCL 484.2101 et seq, under Transmittal No. 2.

This filing modifies Parts I & VI (LTTS) to reflect revisions to the reciprocal compensation rates in compliance with FCC Rules 51.705(c)(3) and 51.909(h). FCC Rule 51.705 (c)(3) requires that no carrier's Non-Access Reciprocal Compensation rate shall exceed the carrier's tariffed interstate access rate in effect in the same year for the equivalent functionality. FCC Rule 51.909(h)(1)(i) requires that beginning on or about July 1, 2020, each Rate-of-Return (ROR) carrier shall establish interstate and intrastate terminating End Office Access Services rates such that its Terminating End Office Access Service Rate does not exceed \$.0000 per minute. FCC Rule 51.909(h) further provides that such ROR carrier's intrastate terminating end office access rates may not exceed the comparable interstate terminating end office rates.

Pursuant to FCC Rule 51.903(d), End Office Access Service means the local switching rate element for ROR carriers whose LTTS rates are disaggregated into three rate elements. This filing reduces the applicable local switching rate element to \$.0000 per minute.
