Dear Ms. Ancona:

Enclosed is one copy of Hiawatha Telephone Company's (Hiawatha) Tariff M.P.S.C. No. 1(R) revisions for filing with the Commission pursuant to Public Act 179 of 1991, as amended, MCL 484.2101 et seq.

This filing (1) eliminates the separate charge for the optional feature of having an unlisted phone number for any Safety+net Bundled Phone and Internet Offering, making the feature available free of charge to customers of that bundle; (2) confirms the current practice of charging \$1.00 per month for an unlisted number for customers with other calling plans; and (3) reduces the monthly rate for the Safety+net Bundled Phone and Internet Offering with up to 150Mb download/10 Mb upload speeds.

The effective date of these tariffs is July 1, 2018.

SAFETY+ net BUNDLED PHONE
AND INTERNET OFFERING

EXCHANGE: Applicable to All Exchanges

- A. The Company is offering a bundled local telephone exchange and internet access service offering. This service includes the following features and functionalities:
1. Unlimited and untimed local calling to the following local exchanges: Eckerman (274), Munising (387), Shingleton (452), Paradise (492), Grand Marais (494), Seney (499), Hiawatha Forest (573), Deer Park (658), Hulbert (876), and Brimley (248).
 2. Unlimited incoming intrastate and interstate long distance or interexchange calls
 3. Access to emergency service 911 calls
 4. Access to Directory Listing Number Services 411 calls
 5. Access to 211/711/811 calls
 6. Voice grade access to the public switched network
 7. Dual tone multi-frequency signaling or its functional equivalent (Touch Tone service)
 8. Single-party service or its functional equivalent
 9. "1 plus the number" toll service is restricted/blocked on outgoing calls. Outgoing toll calls may be made only on a "dial-around" basis using a long distance carrier's access code.
 10. Jamadots High Speed Internet Service at the speeds and rates described below.

- B. -\$53.00* - with Internet service of up to 6Mb download/1Mb upload speeds
-\$62.00* – with Internet service of up to 15Mb download/2 Mb upload speeds
-\$65.00* – with Internet service of up to 30Mb download/4 Mb upload speeds
-\$65.00* – with Internet service of up to 70Mb download/ 10 Mb upload speeds
-\$95.00* – with Internet service of up to 70Mb download/25 Mb upload speeds
-\$85.00* – with Internet service of up to 100Mb download/10 Mb upload speeds
-\$135.00* – with Internet service of up to 100Mb download/25 Mb upload speeds
-\$75.00* – with Internet service of up to 150Mb download/10 Mb upload speeds (R)
-\$155.00* – with Internet service of up to 150Mb download/25 Mb upload speeds

C. Optional Features

1. An optional feature package is available which includes Caller ID/Name and Number - \$3.00/month
2. Customer may have its phone number unlisted in any printed or electronic phone directory available to the general public – Free of Charge (R)
3. Inside Wire Maintenance (repair to wiring on the customer's side of network interface) - \$1.00/month

D. Terms, Conditions, Eligibility and Requirements for Service

1. The current terms and conditions for these offerings may be found in the Internet Service Agreement and Internet Installation Agreement provided to the customer in connection with subscription to the service offerings.
2. Service and construction charges set forth in the Company's tariffs apply, except an existing local exchange service customer of the Company does not have to pay the establishment of service or line connection charges.
3. This offering is only available where facilities exist to offer one or more of the Jamadots High Speed Internet Plans. Not all plans are available in all areas.

*State taxes, federal taxes, and E-911 charges apply.

LOCAL TELEPHONE EXCHANGE SERVICE

DIRECTORY LISTINGS

A. GENERAL

1. Directory Listing regulations apply to listings in the regular alphabetical list of names of customers, commonly referred to as "white pages".
2. A listing in the alphabetical section of the directory is provided to a customer without extra charge. Listings are intended primarily for the purpose of identification and are limited to information which is essential to such identification. Directories are furnished and the Telephone Company reserves the right to refuse to insert any listing in its directories which does not facilitate directory service.
3. The length of any listing is limited to one line by the use of abbreviations when the clearness of the listing and the identification of the customer are not impaired thereby. When more than one line is required to properly list the customer, no additional charge is made.
4. The Telephone Company will refuse to list in the alphabetical section of the telephone directory any listing which does not constitute a legally authorized and adopted name, and/or any name which is likely to mislead or deceive the public as to the identity of the customer, or consisting of figures and symbols, or which is inserted for advertising purposes, or which is more elaborate than is reasonably necessary to identify the customer. The Telephone Company will withdraw any listing which is found to violate the above rule.
5. When a customer contracts for more than one individual line of the same class and at the same location, consecutive telephone numbers may be assigned to such lines and in such cases the use of more than one listing is unnecessary for the efficient handling of the service.
6. Upon written request, a customer's listing may be omitted from the directory for a monthly charge of \$1.00. (C) (I)
A connection with such non-published stations are completed only when requested by telephone number.

B. BUSINESS LISTING

1. A listing must be the name of the individual, partnership, corporation, firm, association, institution etc., to whom service is furnished; or the name of a member, officer, employee or representative thereof; or the name of another business house which the customer represents; controls or owns. Listings other than those specified herein are available only in connection with Joint User Service.
2. The listing of a service, commodity or trade name - such as "Coal; 237 W. 5th Street; 346-5376:" - appearing in the sequence of alphabetical names is not permitted.
3. When a customer is engaged in more than one line of business, only the business by which he is best known will ordinarily be included in the business designation.
4. Double name listings or the use of titles such as "Pres.", "V-Pres.", "Mgr.", , etc., are not permitted - for example, "Paramount Supply Co., John Drake, Manager; 243-4365.
5. Listings of telephones in churches will not include in the same listing the name of the church and also that of its pastor or of organizations or societies associated therewith.
6. A caption listing - for example, the listing Masonic Temple under which is indented Auditorium, Banquet Room, Chapter Floor, each with telephone number - is provided only if necessary for the efficient use of the service; no additional charge is made for the caption listing. The caption must be of an essential part of the listings which follow. The names of individual are not inserted under a caption, but will be shown in their proper alphabetical sequence in the directory. Indented listings which do not materially add to the information contained in the caption or which are designed to advertise the extent of the customer's business are not permitted.
