Enclosed is one copy of The Telecommunications Association of Michigan (TAM) Tariff M.P.S.C. No. 9R for filing with the Commission pursuant to Public Act 179 of 1991, as amended, MCL 484.2101 et seq.

This tariff will ease the administration of tariff provisions pertaining to State and Federal Lifeline Programs by having a single tariff containing the schedule of charges and regulations governing state and federal low-income consumer discounts in which Local Exchange Carriers belonging to TAM are concurring carriers. As the requirements of state or federal law governing Lifeline programs are changed, a single set of tariff changes to Tariff M.P.S.C. No. 9R may be made instead of requiring more than 30 separate tariff filings to the local exchange tariffs of each concurring carrier.
