LOCAL TELEPHONE EXCHANGE SERVICE
SAFETY NET ACCESS LINE

(N)

EXCHANGE: Applicable to All Exchanges

- A. The Company is offering a local telephone exchange service called Safety Net Access Line. This service includes the following features and functionalities:
1. Unlimited incoming intrastate and interstate long distance or interexchange calls
 2. Access to emergency service 911 calls
 3. Access to Directory Listing Number Services 411 calls
 4. Access to 211/711/811 calls
 5. Voice grade access to the public switched network
 6. Dual tone multi-frequency signaling or its functional equivalent (Touch Tone service)
 7. Single-party service or its functional equivalent
 8. "1 plus the number" toll service is restricted/blocked on outgoing calls. Outgoing toll calls may be made only on a "dial-around" basis using a long distance carrier's access code.
 9. Unlimited and untimed local calling to the following local exchanges: Watton/Covington/Sidnaw (355), Golden Lake (472) and Trout Creek/Kenton (852).
- B. Monthly Rate
- \$5.00, including all applicable state and federal taxes and fees, except E911 charges.
- C. Optional Features
1. An optional features package is available which includes Caller ID/Name and Number and Inside Wire Maintenance (repair to wiring on the customer's side of the network interface) - \$5.00/month
 2. Customer may have its phone number unlisted in any printed or electronic phone directory available to the general public - \$1.00/month
- D. Terms, Conditions, Eligibility and Requirements for Service
1. The Safety Net Access Line is not a stand-alone service offering. Eligibility for the Safety Net Access Line requires the customer to be concurrently subscribed at applicable rates to a Jamadots High-Speed Internet Service offering referenced below. The customer's discontinuance of or non-payment for the Jamadots High Speed Internet Service Plan shall result in disconnection of the Safety Net Access Line.
 2. The Jamadots High Speed Internet Service Plans, which satisfy the eligibility requirement to subscribe to the Safety Net Access Line, include:
 - (a) A service offering up to 6 Mb download speed/1 Mb upload speed or;
 - (b) A service offering up to 15 Mb download speed/2 Mb upload speed

The current rates, term commitment, terms and conditions for these High Speed Internet service plans may be found at <http://www.jamadots.com> and in the service order confirmation or the contract sent to the customer in connection with subscription to the Jamadots High Speed Internet services.
 3. Service and construction charges set forth in these tariffs apply, except an existing local exchange service customer of the Company does not have to pay the establishment of service or line connection charges.
 4. Safety Net Access Line is only offered where facilities exist to offer one or more of the Jamadots High Speed Internet Plans.

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
