6. Switched Access Service

6.1 General

This description is an exception to NECA Tariff F.C.C. No. 5, Section 6.1. For all purposes involving the rates, terms, conditions, billing and provisioning of intrastate switched access service by issuing carriers under MECA Tariff M.P.S.C. No. 25(U), "Switched Access Service" as described in Section 6.1 and used in MECA Tariff M.P.S.C. 25(U), provides, without regard to LATA boundaries, the ability to originate calls from an end user's premise to a customer's designated premise both of which premises are located in Michigan, and to terminate calls from a customer's designated premise to an end user's premise, both of which premises are located in Michigan.
